Preregistration, Permission, and Other Enrollment Notes

- ³ Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.
- ⁴ Psych 150 is open *only* to new Northwestern students with AP or transfer credit for Psych 110. Eligible students will be contacted in the summer with registration details.
- ⁵ Get a permission number for 205 from Ms. Ginger Gilmore in the psychology department office. Numbers will be given out at set times the week prior to registration. See [Swift Thinking](#) for details.
- ⁶ Applications for permission to enroll in 326 will be available from Ms. Ginger Gilmore in the psychology department office at set times the week prior to registration. Accepted students will be given permission numbers and will then be able to enroll through CAESAR. See [Swift Thinking](#) for details.
- ⁷ For 397 and 399, get an application from Ginger. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to Ginger and get a permission number. For 398, get a permission number from Ginger; you must be on the list given to her by the honors coordinator, Prof. Uttal.
