PREREQUISITE FOR MOST COURSES: 110 Introduction to Psychology

BASIC RESEARCH SEQUENCE: 201 Statistical Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 110*)
 205 Research Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 201*)

AT LEAST 7 ADDITIONAL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES, including:
 (1) at least 2 from Column A (Row 1 or Row 2) (4) at least 1 from Row 2 (which also counts
 (2) at least 2 from Column B (Row 1 or Row 2) for whichever column it is in)
 (3) at least 3 300-level Psychology department courses

FIVE RELATED COURSES (REQUIRED IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE)

Two 200-level mathematics courses plus **three additional courses** chosen from the following:
 Mathematics at the 200-level or higher; Statistics at the 300-level; Biological Sciences, Chemistry, or
 Physics at any level; Anthropology 213; Cognitive Science 207; Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD)
 202, 301, and 302; EECS (formerly Computer Science) 110, 111, 130, and 395. With department permission,
 Psych 351 may count toward this requirement instead of as a psychology course.
