BASIC RESEARCH SEQUENCE: 201 Statistical Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 110*)
205 Research Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 201*)

AT LEAST 4 ADDITIONAL PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT COURSES, chosen from among those counting toward the major, and including:

- (1) at least 1 from Column A below
- (2) at least 1 from Column B below
- (3) at least 2 300-level Psychology department courses
